Best Selling Children's Book Author Has New Book In Time For Outdoor/Hiking Season

Canmore, Alberta, Canada. April 22, 2009. Carol McTavish has done it again. Her *Never Bug A Bear* is a lovely story, beautifully illustrated by artist/illustrator Linden Wentzloff, about preserving and protecting wild animal habitat. The interactive story takes young children through a search of each animal's habitat to find a loveable and knowledgeable bug, 'Humphrey', on each page.

Ms McTavish has two of her first three books from her Wilderness Series listed as Canadian Best Sellers: *In the Path of Great Bear* and *Magic In the Mountains*.
